Dress Code Reminders

A friendly reminder regarding leggings and makeup.

- Leggings, with or without pockets, are not allowed to be worn as school uniform pants. Leggings may be worn under skirts and jumpers. Leggings are allowed on out-of-uniform days if the accompanying shirt is covers the student's bottom when they raise their hands over their head.
- Makeup is not allowed at school. This included mascara and lipstick.

Students who are repeatedly out of the dress code may lose the privilege of wearing leggings and/or may serve detention.
