Parking Lot Reminders

The speed limit in the parking lot is 5 mph. For the safety of all, please mind the 5 mph limit until you are driving on the main road.

During morning drop off, parents who are dropping off their students should be joining one of the two drop off loops. One loop from Oklahoma Avenue goes past the playground structure. The second loop from Euclid Avenue goes up the middle towards the gym building and loops around in front of the gym building. The loops should be started right away when cars start arriving but students shouldn't exit the cars until 7:35 as there is no supervision until then. Parking your car and letting students walk across driving lanes is dangerous - use the loops instead so your child is not in a dangerous situation.
