Hello, St. Matthias community!

I am reaching out as a longtime parent (15 years) of St. Matthias Parish School. While there have been many changes in the 15 years our children have attended this school, I believe one thing remains the same. Our school will only be as strong as its support system.

At St. Matthias we have dedicated teachers and staff that instruct and guide our children daily. We have sports and extra-curriculars to develop our children's abilities physically, mentally, and socially. We have had yearly picnics, dances for the middle schoolers, and other social activities/fundraisers in the past. All of these opportunities provide us as parents an opportunity to give back to our children's school, support our children, and develop our own friendships as parents. Needless to say, COVID-19 impacted every school community and for some time these opportunities were lost to us.

As our children are now back in school and some activities are resuming (sports and the recent Trunk or Treat for example), we as parents are now needed to step up into roles to again support our children and our school. I have heard people talk about a school picnic, 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation, and other activities, wondering what will be able to take place given the ongoing COVID situation. What we can control at this time is our effort and level of involvement. Our children need, and deserve, our support.

Currently Home and School has only one member who is taking care of all the tasks that are usually completed by an entire committee. This committee usually assists with items related to the school picnic, which is one of the students' favorite activities each year. I have heard talk about the picnic, but without parents to step up and assist with planning early on, this will be difficult to execute. School Advisory Committee is currently looking for parents to assist on subcommittees, the descriptions of which are listed below.

In my many years as a parent here, I have manned the concessions stand, volunteered in the classrooms, assisted with classroom parties, coached track, served as a SAC committee member, worked at the school picnic, and chaperoned middle school dances, just to name a few items. I have had the opportunity to meet some wonderful people and make some true friends. I have also had the opportunity to watch my children socially in many of these instances. It is truly joyful to watch your children grow and thrive in their element. This is more than just a place your children attend school if you get involved. St. Matthias is another community, another family.
