#### **Out of Uniform Leggings**

Girls who want to wear leggings on out of uniform days are expected to wear a shirt that fully covers their bottom. Shirts worn with leggings must cover bottoms when hands are raised. Student who do not follow the dress code expectations may lose their right to participate in future Spirit and Out of Uniform days and/or will lose the privilege of wearing leggings on out of uniform days.

#### **Coat Wearing Policy**

Wisconsin weather can change drastically in one week making cool days seem very warm to kids. When this happens, students often want to take their coats off on days when it is still chilly. Beginning Monday, December 18, the following policy will go into effect. Students are expected to wear outerwear during recess and before and after school. If the temperature is 60 degrees or above, students will be allowed to take off their coats. If the temperature outside is 50-59 degrees, students will be allowed to unzip their jackets. If the temperature is below 50, students will be expected to zip and wear their jackets.
