Game Re-caps

The manager of St. Matthias changed tactics a bit, for the bottom of the 9th. He had all three batters, including himself, shoot for the triple. Needless to say, no one got a hit, and they went down in order. It should be noted that all three outs were wire shots, and would have been a single. *Box Score: St. Matthias 1 runs on 4 hits; Mother of Perpetual Help (B) 3 runs on 8 hits; 7 runs on 15 hits.*
